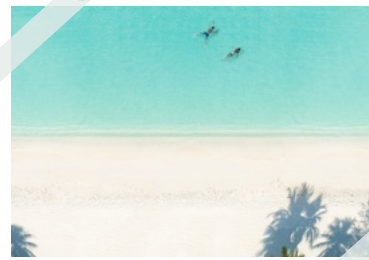


Grand Cayman Bucket List

Nature & Wildlife Experiences

- Stingray City** – Interact with friendly stingrays in shallow sandbars.
- Starfish Point** – See beautiful starfish in crystal-clear, shallow waters.
- Rum Point** – Relax at this picturesque beach, known for calm waters and coconut palms.
- Queen Elizabeth II Botanic Park** – Explore native plants and see the endangered blue iguana.
- Mastic Trail** – Hike this 200-year-old forest trail filled with rare flora and fauna.
- Cayman Turtle Centre** – Learn about and interact with green sea turtles.
- Crystal Caves** – Tour these limestone caves with impressive stalactite formations.
- Cayman Sun Splash Tours** – Private boat charters for customized snorkeling and sandbar trips.
- Camana Bay Observation Tower** – Climb for panoramic views of Grand Cayman.
- Bioluminescent Bay Tour** – Witness glowing marine life on a nighttime kayak or boat tour.

Beaches & Coastal Experiences

- Seven Mile Beach** – Relax on Grand Cayman's most famous, award-winning beach.
- Smith's Barcadere** – Enjoy a small, rocky beach great for snorkeling and picnics.
- Governor's Beach** – A quieter area of Seven Mile Beach near the Governor's residence.
- Spotts Beach** – Snorkel with sea turtles in the clear, shallow waters.
- East End Beaches** – Experience secluded beaches and local charm on the east coast.
- Kaibo Beach** – Beachside dining, drinks, and relaxation at this quiet spot near Rum Point.

Family-Friendly Activities

- Dolphin Discovery Grand Cayman** – Interact and swim with dolphins.
- Pirate's Caves Family Park** – Explore caves, a petting zoo, and family activities.
- Queen Elizabeth II Botanic Park** – The new Children's Garden features a splash pad, observation tower and discovery pond.



Snorkeling & Diving Adventures

- Kittiwake Shipwreck & Artificial Reef** – Dive or snorkel at this sunken ship, a marine habitat.
- Devil's Grotto** – A famous dive site with caverns and abundant marine life.
- Bloody Bay Wall** (Little Cayman) – World-renowned wall dive with incredible visibility.
- Eden Rock and Devil's Rock** – Shore dives known for colorful coral and fish.
- Cemetery Beach** – Quiet beach with excellent offshore snorkeling.

Cultural & Historical Sites

- Pedro St. James Castle** – Tour a historic mansion and learn about Caymanian heritage.
- Cayman Islands National Museum** – Discover local history, artifacts, and natural exhibits.
- Bodden Town Pirate Caves** – Explore man-made caves and learn about pirate history.
- Mission House** – Visit this restored historic home in Bodden Town.
- Cayman Craft Market** – Browse local handmade crafts, souvenirs, and unique gifts.

Shopping & Entertainment

- Camana Bay** – Enjoy shops, restaurants, and events in a waterfront town center.
- George Town Duty-Free Shopping** – Explore high-end boutiques and duty-free shops.
